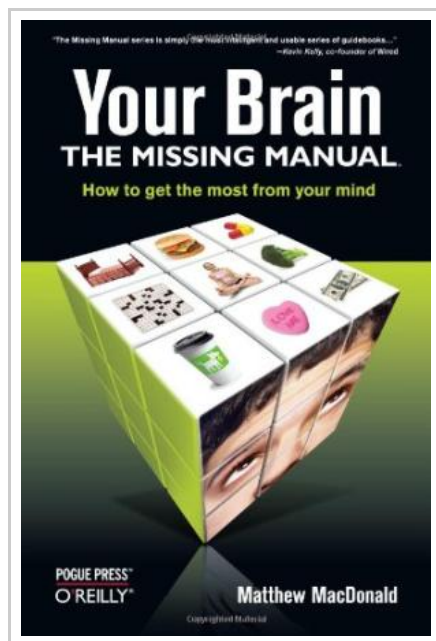




Your Brain: The Missing Manual
