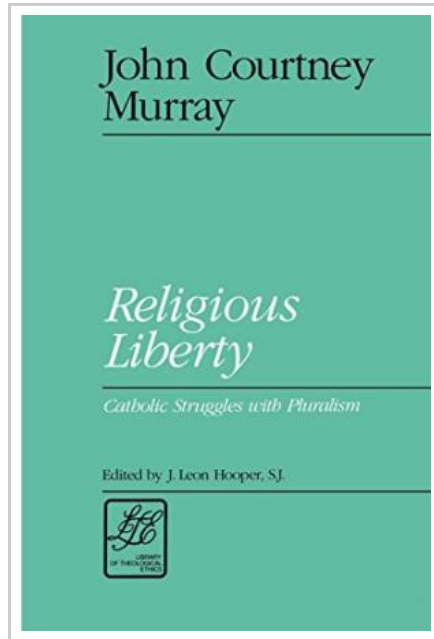




Religious Liberty
